

## Student Outcomes – Graduating Class of 2019

Class of 2019 includes graduates from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

Data were collected from exit surveys at the time of graduation and follow-up surveys six months after graduation. Student Outcomes Surveys distributed six months after Spring graduation to all students graduating between July 1, 2018, and June 30, 2019. Outcomes from all sources were compiled to provide the following data. For those who provided multiple responses, the most recent data were used. Employment rates are based on the number with employment outcomes (based on NACE definitions) among those for whom data were available.

### Undergraduate Students

The total undergraduate class included 501 graduates. Outcomes were known for 290 students, giving us a knowledge rate of 58%
